### **Professional Resume**

You can use some of these categories, but do not have to use all of them. Design the resume to fit your own professional career.

- Present Position/Employment
- Education – college courses if applicable, craft classes you have taken; people with whom you studied, etc.

### **Work Samples**

Submit three (3) examples of your best work from the last three years **and** five(5) photographs on CD, showing range and variety as much as possible within the chosen medium and category. Of course, the criteria will vary according to medium and category. However, examples of what the committee is looking for include functionality, creativity, unique design, as well as craftsmanship in the form of smooth edges, uniform glazes and stains, seamless joints; finished edges, etc.
